Approval of Agenda

A motion was made by Mrs. Eddins and seconded by Mr. Murdock to approve the agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Review Policies:

Discipline – Discipline policies 3380 and 3390 were reviewed. At present, there are three grievance policies. These policies need to be reviewed and revised as necessary.

Emergency Closures- A motion was made by Mr. Murdock and seconded by Mrs. Eddins to accept the Emergency Closure Policy 1009 as presented on first reading. Second reading will be done at the regular meeting in March. Motion passed unanimously.

Absences – A motion was made by Mr. Murdock and seconded by Mrs. Small to accept the Absence Policy 3050 as presented on first reading. Second reading will be done at the regular meeting in March. Motion passed unanimously.

Truancy – Ms. Gordon gave board members the Idaho Statute to review. Policy 3040 will be rewritten and updated for the next meeting.

Superintendent Evaluation/Contract: It as agreed that Mr. Jorgensen would write an evaluation and read it at the next board meeting.

All board members were in agreement to rehire Ms. Gordon for the next school year. A contract needs to be worked on for the next year. The board asked Ms. Gordon to write a list of areas she has dealt with this year and the actions which were taken to demonstrate accomplishments and goals.

Plan for Bus Drivers and Coaches: It was agreed that research needs to be done on bus driver pay and coaches salaries for the upcoming year. This may be an area that needs to be revisited this year.

Athletic Director: It was noted that there are camps being offered for the athletic director.

Review Improvement Plan: This is a five-year plan which needs to be reviewed. It was also noted that the district needs to be aware of any teachers leaving.

Survey of Community: It was agreed that a survey needs to be done of the community to evaluate what classes and activities the community would like to see offered at the school. It was mentioned that soccer might be an interest as well as classes in robotics.

It was also noted that the band had 15 students who qualified for honor band at the district competitions.

A motion was made by Ms. Korrell and seconded by Mrs. Eddins to adjourn.
